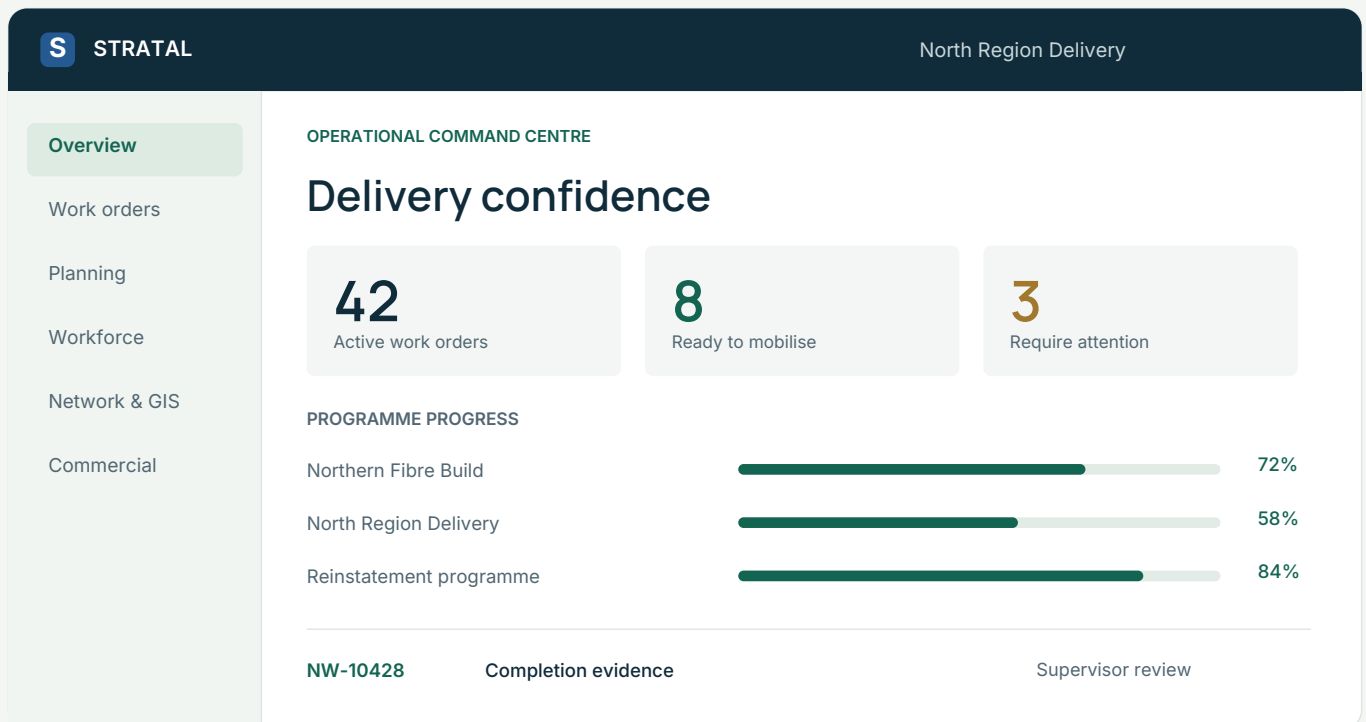

## 03 Prepare with confidence.

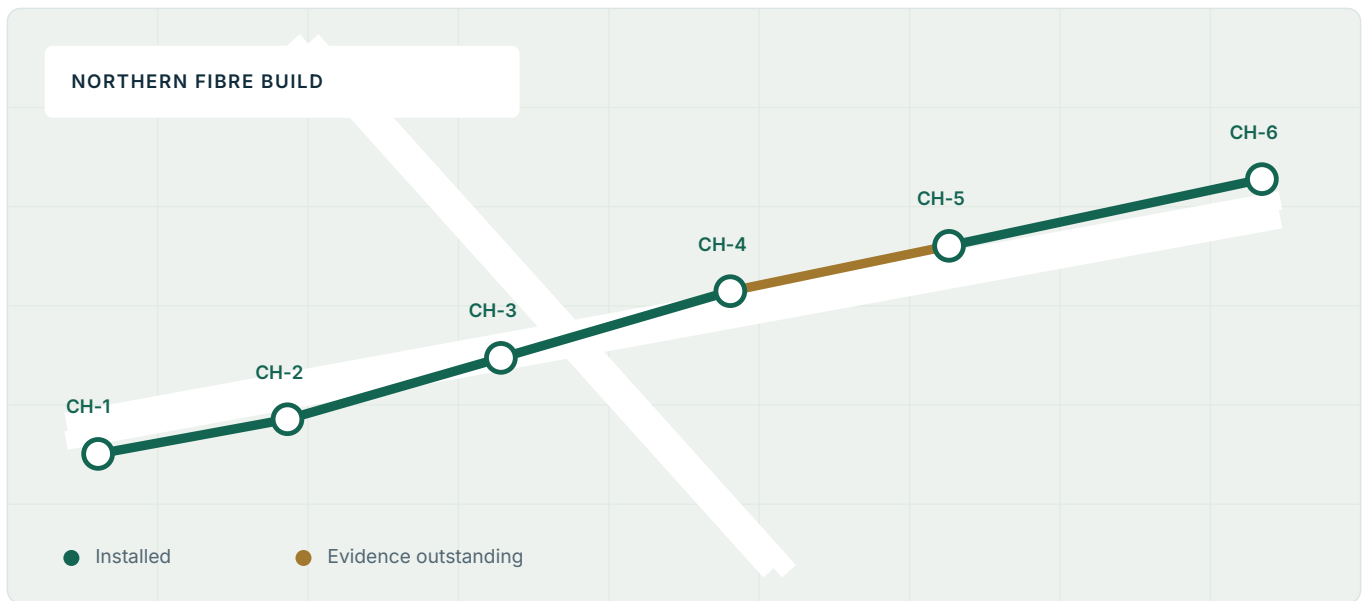
Connect delivery context to assurance, variations, applications and client reporting, reducing the need to reconstruct the job later.

# Spot the blocker. Own the next action.

Use routes, chambers, ducts and work sections to understand build progress.

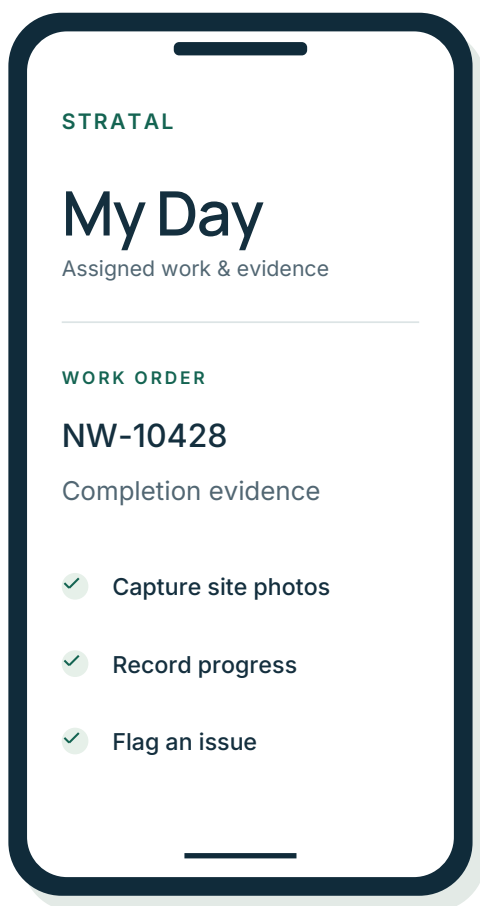
## Focus the review.

# Capture it at source. Keep it connected.

Give field teams a focused working day, while building the record that supervisors, assurance and commercial teams rely on.

## 01 Start with the right work.

Present assigned jobs and priorities through the field PWA, keeping the experience focused on delivery.

## 02 Make the record useful.

Attach photos, daily activity and progress to the work, so evidence retains its operational context.

## 03 Keep review moving.

Bring issues and outstanding records into supervisor and assurance workflows for follow-up.

**Controlled documents, on the same journey.** Connect drawings, RAMS, permits and packs with revision and approval context.

# Connect delivery to commercial value.

The commercial story starts on site. Keep evidence, changes and delivered work close to the teams preparing applications and reviewing the account.

Progress, photos, documents and work history.

### Change & review

Variations, quantities and outstanding evidence.

3

### Application & closeout

Supporting records for commercial and client review.

## Variations

Keep the reason for a change and its supporting evidence together.

## Claims & applications

Prepare reviews with delivery context and structured records.

## Retentions & CVR

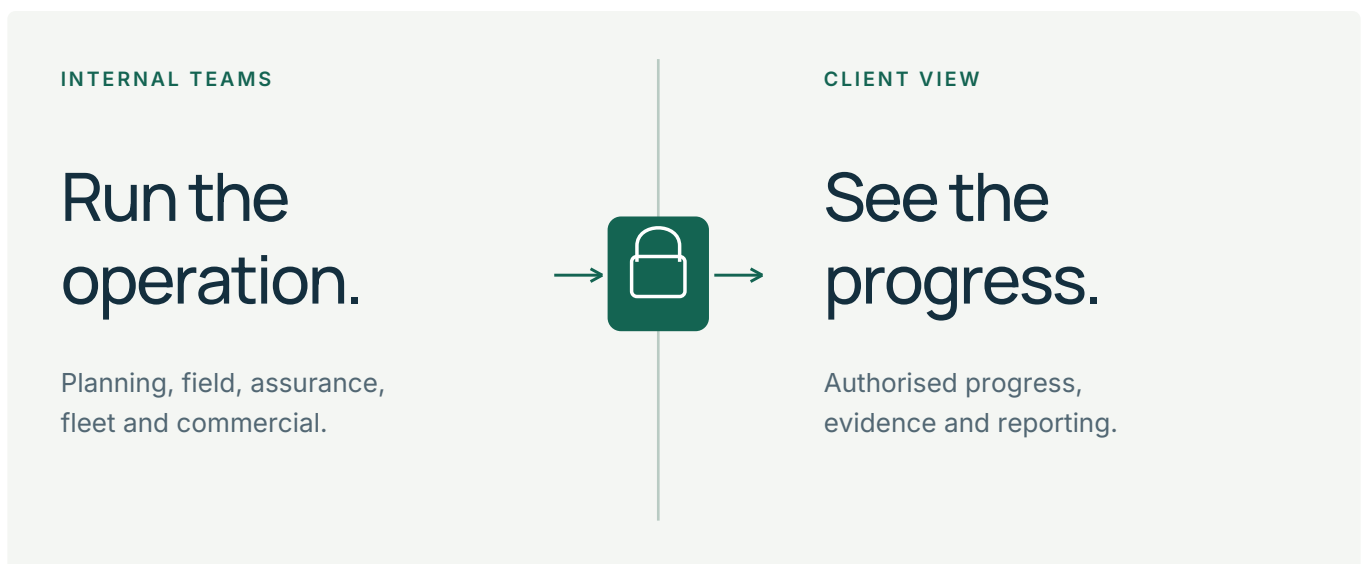
Keep retained value, margins and cost value reconciliation in view.

Support authorised evidence downloads, programme reporting, faults and service information for multiple client users.

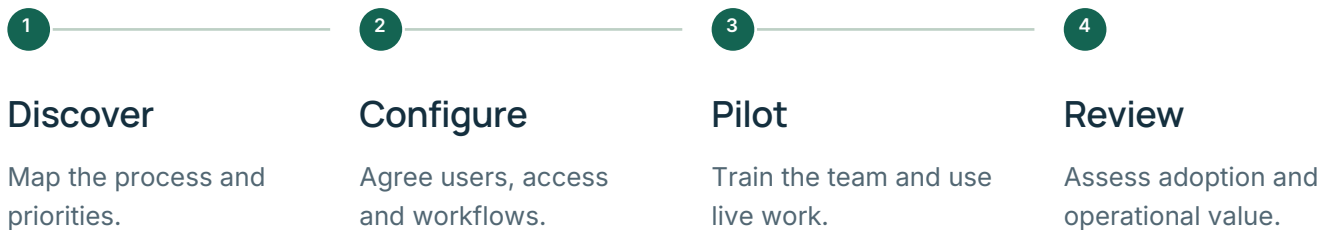
## Keep assurance accountable.
